## FROM THE WELL

I told the following story at a conference a couple of weeks ago and I thought I would share it with you. Sue Mallory author of the *Equipping Church* told this about her friend and colleague Don Simmons.

Several years ago, Don had a brain aneurism and almost died. The “brain bleed” as he is fond of calling it, left him paralyzed and unable to speak. Midway through his rehab, his orderly started rolling him outside in a wheelchair as part of his therapy. One day as Don was practicing his speech by naming the different trees and plants, he pointed to a beautiful church across the street and said to his orderly/friend, “*aren’t those beautiful stain glass windows?*” The orderly quickly replied, “*That church doesn’t have any windows.*” Don immediately responded back, “*Yes it does. Don’t you see those beautiful stain glass windows?*” The orderly shot back, “*That church doesn’t have any windows. It only has mirrors. All they can see is themselves.*”

As it turned out, the church had once been one of the largest churches in the city—worshipping almost a thousand people. Now there are barely a hundred. It was a beautiful building but they had ignored the changing community around them and they were near death.

I tell this story as a way of explaining to churches that they must get outside of themselves if they hope to thrive in the 21st century. I tell you this story because Central has windows everywhere! Central is a healthy, thriving, growing church because it is engaging the community. It is a place where people truly feel welcomed and affirmed. I work with so many churches that are struggling and are in decline. As I do, I thank God every day for Central. Thank you for helping to make Central such a wonderful place to worship and be in ministry.

## CHURCH HISTORY MINUTE

As Monroe began to grow in 1873-1874, after the railroad was finished through the county, the Methodist congregation also had growing pains. It was outgrowing its little log church at the corner of Church and Windsor Streets. It was at this time that the Mecklenburg Presbytery approved a mission church to be founded in Monroe--in September of 1873. It was chartered with 16 members and proceeded to buy the Methodist Church building for \$1400. Of course this is the site of First Presbyterian Church today. The deed was executed on 30 January 1875 after the Methodist moved their second building on the northwest corner of Windsor and Hayne Streets. (This is the present site of the two-story brick building built by Monroe Hardware for their wholesale business.)

The little log church building served the Presbyterians until 1902 when they built a fine new brick structure at the same time the Methodists were building their third building two blocks away. The log building was moved to Vernon Lockhart's farm in the 1300 block of East Franklin Street to be used as a barn. It was not torn down until the 1960s. Dr. Bill McLeod has made a scale model of this log building and it is housed in the Presbyterian Church. We borrowed it several years ago to display on a Heritage Sunday. To be continued--
