Kindergarten REGISTRATION

Typically Kindergarten registration takes place in February. Although we have not received any information at this time we wanted to let you know so you can be ready. You will need the that you will need the following information to register your student for kindergarten:

- Birth certificate
- Immunization record that includes a doctor's signature or a clinic's stamp as proof the vaccines were given.
- Proof of residence.
- Before the first day of school, you will also need to provide your school with a completed Kindergarten Health Assessment Report. The form must be signed by a doctor and include all of the information requested on the form.
